

François Soyer is Associate Professor in History at the University of New England (NSW, Australia). He researches the history of Anti-Judaism and Antisemitism in Europe; the Iberian inquisitions and sexuality and gender in early modern Spain and Portugal. He has published 6 books, including “Popularizing anti-semitism in early modern Spain and its empire. Francisco de Torrejoncillo and the Centinela contra Judíos (1674)” (Brill 2014), *Antisemitic Conspiracy Theories in the Early Modern Iberian World* (Brill, 2019) and *Medieval Antisemitism?* (ARC, 2019) as well as over 40 peer-reviewed book chapters and articles.
